

Sharyland ISD District of Innovation Plan 2019-2023



HB 1842 was passed during the 84th Texas Legislative Session, and provides Texas public school districts the opportunity to be designated as Districts of Innovation. To access these flexibilities, a school district must adopt an innovation plan, as set forth in Texas Education Code (TEC) Chapter 12A.

The Sharyland ISD Board of Trustees appointed the district’s DEIC committee to develop a local innovation plan that seeks to improve the delivery of instructional services for students through the requested exemption of §TEC 25.0811 (First Day of Instruction). **Sharyland ISD will only seek exemption of §TEC 25.0811 during the 5-year plan.** The exemption will only include the calendar start date, not an extension to the school day or work week. Sharyland ISD Board of Trustees further commits not to amend the District of Innovation Plan during the 5-year term. As a District of Innovation, SISD is not allowed to utilize other exemptions. Any proposed changes to this plan must go through the entire District of Innovation process as listed in 19 TAC §102.1307.

§TEC 25.0811 states that students may not begin school before the 4th Monday of August. The proposal will allow for a calendar that fits the local needs of the Sharyland ISD communities which may include a student start date earlier than the 4th Monday of August but no earlier than the 3rd Monday of August. The plan will adhere to 187 working days for teachers and at least 75,600 minutes of operation as required by §TEC 25.081.

Rationale for Flexibility:

- Increases instructional days before state assessments at all levels.
- Allows for periodic planning time throughout the school year for staff.
- Gives the potential to start summer school earlier and to provide additional interventions to struggling students.
